Footnotes

ROYAL HILL , tucked up nicely saving ground behind the leaders, eased out in upper stretch, leaned in a bit when launching his bid leaving the eighth pole, was straightened away left handed, took command a sixteenth out and drew clear under a drive. DIP MY BEAK set a pressured pace towards the inside, shook clear nearing the eighth pole, was collared soon after and stayed on well. HISTORY AHEAD lost ground five wide while rating off the pace, steadied briefly leaving the three eighths pole, continued well wide into the lane and closed willingly through the last eighth. SCHOOL HOUSE , unhurried early while saving ground, waited for room when advancing in upper stretch, split rivals leaving the eighth pole and closed willingly. EIGHTEEN TWELVE , unhurried early, saved ground into the lane, swung out five wide and had some belated action. CHILKOOT TRAIL prompted the pace two to three wide, came under a ride mid way on the final turn, failed to seriously respond and gave way in mid stretch. AMERI WEBER stalked the pace three wide, was asked for run around the far turn and faded. WINGO STAR , sluggish from the gate, settled back off the pace, raced between rivals leaving the far turn, checked off heels near the quarter pole, angled out and finished with some interest. QUIET VICTORY saved ground, raced in range under a ride leaving the five sixteenths pole and faded. ROMAN CANDLE LIGHT , in range five wide for six furlongs, gave way. SNEAKY LOUIS was floated out six wide entering the first turn and failed to menace. PEACE FROG , three to four wide between rivals while chasing the pace, faltered after six furlongs.
