Footnotes

LEMON JUICE , urged along chasing the pace off the rail, quickly gained three to four wide after a half mile, took over with three sixteenths to go, drove clear and drifted in some. SACHICOMULA prompted three wide under rating, took over in hand around the far turn, kicked clear past three eighths pole, was joined by the winner entering the stretch, continued on willingly and was clearly second best. THE CALLER rated early off the pace and off the inside, was given his cue after three eighths, made a slight four wide run into the stretch then flattened out. OUR BAILIWICK saved ground without threatening. C. LADY'S WARRIOR stumbled to his nose at the break and bumped soundly with MOONLIGHT GIN, lagged back, swung wide for the drive but failed to menace. THREEANDDONEDAN chased early while saving ground, angled out near the three eighths pole, failed kick in and gradually gave way. MOONLIGHT GIN was bumped very hard at the break, raced very wide in upper stretch and could not recover. GO SIX GO , hustled to the front, set the early pace towards the rail and faltered.
