Footnotes

YES I'M LUCKY cleared early and dropped in to set the pace, dictated under a light hold around the turn, entered the lane two wide, responded when given his cue three sixteenths out and drew away impressively under mild hand encouragement. TIGER BOURBON gained a forward position along the rail after a sixteenth of a mile, steadied when in close entering the far turn, had his rider tap on the brakes losing position three furlongs out, regrouped to make a rail run in upper stretch, gave willing chase but was simply no match for the winner. KING RACER raced close up between rivals into the turn, stalked three wide around the turn, gave hard pursuit past the furlong grounds and gave way grudgingly. GALLIVANTING was hung out five wide into the turn while tracking the pace, dropped back some mid turn, continued five wide into the lane, was put to the whip inside the quarter pole and came up empty. OTOY , four wide between rivals early, stalked four wide around the turn, came under pressure into the stretch, failed to kick on and faded through the final eighth of a mile. TAKE TIME TO PRAY was steadied back from between rivals into the turn, angled to the four path and dropped back through the lane.
