Footnotes

STRATHNAVER (GB) , patiently rated between horses, responded after being swung to the five path at the head of the stretch, closed nicely and was up late. ABACO lacked speed, worked between horses leaving the far turn, swung to the outside in midstretch and closed late. HUNTER FORWARD (AUS) , a forward factor inside horses, advanced in the two path to reach contention in midstretch, gained a brief lead near the sixteenth pole then finished gamely inside the top pair. ASK ME ANYTHING , never far back, circled the far turn in the four path then failed to rally in an even effort. EMBARR saved ground on the far turn, eased out turning for home, got caught behind horses in midstretch, angled in to the two path and finished willingly. MALIBU YANKEE , no factor, was well off the rail in the stretch and passed tired horses. NAMASKARA , four wide the first turn, raced five deep the far turn and was not a factor. NASHLY'S VOW prompted the pace two wide, gained a clear lead leaving the far turn, angled to the rail for the drive and gave way the final furlong. WELCOME DANCE stalked the pace, advanced three deep on the far turn to reach a striking position then faltered in midstretch. IDLE TALK , wide the first turn, saved ground the far turn and was outrun. FERRY MUSIC , three wide the far turn, was outrun. LION DOWN BY ME showed speed along the rail and faltered in upper stretch.
