MISSY LIVE OAK saved ground and rallied mildly. CUSSIE'S MIRROR , very wide, failed to rally. BRIEFBUSTER hesitated leaving the starting gate, raced along the rail and rallied mildly. ENJOYABLE , very wide, was no factor. ALLIE'S SMILE , wide, lacked a rally. ARTSY GIRL chased the pace well off the rail and gave way. TRACEABLE lacked speed, was checked in tight quarters leaving the backstretch and raced inside horses in the stretch. JIVE ALIVE was no factor. DUST BUNNY , outrun, raced eight wide in the stretch. FAMOSA SENORITA

was outrun. INTRICACY was outrun.
