FURRARIAT stalked the pace three wide, lodged a bid leaving the far turn, dueled between rivals into the lane, kicked clear nearing mid stretch then was fully extended to prevail. RANGELEY LITENING , bumped and pinched back at the break, settled well back through the opening five and a half furlongs, swung out seven wide for the drive, closed steadily while lugging in and missed. RICHARD'S KID , never far back under some rating, saved ground leaving the far turn, angled out in upper stretch and rallied between rivals. QUIET SEARCH lost ground four to five wide most of the trip, made a mild run leaving the eighth pole then flattened out late. KIYOSHI prompted the pace two wide, moved to command nearing the three eighths pole while under urging, dueled into the stretch and gave way leaving the eighth pole. INDIAN WAR stalked the pace towards the inside, eased out in upper stretch and faded. NO PATIENCE HERE , brushed at the break, settled off the rail, moved closer four wide nearing the half mile marker, lodged a three wide bid to challenge leaving the far turn, dueled to the head of the lane then faltered leaving mid stretch. JIGALONG broke inward and bumped with RANGELEY LITENING, set the pace inside, was headed leaving the far turn and tired after six furlongs.
