BALTIMORE RAVEN circled the turn, was in the five path near the eighth pole, closed determinedly and was along in time. SKELETON CREW saved ground stalking the pace, gained the lead along the rail in midstretch and continued gamely. BEER STIEN chased the pace, was in the four path in upper stretch and hung between the top pair. MY BULLET lacked speed and had a mild rally along the rail. THAT'S MY MAN accelerated to the front, raced well off the rail and tired in the drive. MICHAEL'S TRIFECTA , between horses in the stretch, weakened. BO DIDDLEY , wide, was not a factor. JO'S MOJO circled the turn and weakened. NORTHEASTERN saved ground and was outrun. HOUND trailed.
