LOOKALIKE lacked speed, was wide down the backstretch, circled the far turn, dueled through the stretch and narrowly prevailed in an extended drive. MISS FLEETFOOT saved ground setting the pace, dueled through the lane with the winner and finished gamely. ME LOVE, three wide both turns, had a mild rally. MUSICAL BREW chased the pace, was in the four path in upper stretch, drifted in near the eighth pole and lacked the needed rally. G. B'S GIRL, two wide entering the stretch, was checked when shut off by GLEN WILDING inside the eighth pole. THE REAL FUTURE, steadied when pinched back soon after the break, raced wide turning for home and was no factor. GLEN WILDING prompted the pace, raced along the rail entering the stretch, gave way and shut off G.B.'S GIRL when drifting out inside the eighth pole. SOFT MUSIC saved ground, chased the pace and gave way. SWAMPOODLE, wide the first turn, stopped. Following a stewards' inquiry and objections by the rider of G.B.'S GIRL against MUSICAL BREW and ME LOVE for alleged interference in the stretch, no action was taken
