Footnotes

TIME FOR TUTT , outrun early, saved ground the first turn, eased out entering the far turn, raced very wide turning for home, lugged in near the eighth pole, closed inside horses and was up in time. LION DRAWING set the pace, raced in the two path entering the stretch, retained a clear advantage to midstretch then gave way grudgingly in the drive'. PORCUPINE stalked the pace near the rail, eased out on the far turn, was three wide between horses entering the stretch and flattened out. AVERIL'S RING , outside horses, chased the pace, raced in the four path entering the stretch and finished willingly. NOT FOR PRIDE saved ground entering the far turn, eased out for the drive, worked between horses and failed to rally. SENOR RUTLEDGE saved ground the far turn, eased out for the drive and failed to be a factor. DETROIT IRON saved ground and weakened in midstretch. GIANT TALENT , wide both turns, was not a factor. PERFECT CRUISE was outrun. SUNSHINE RAHY , off the rail, chased the pace for six furlongs then gave way. PIANO RED , three wide on the turns, was outrun. ANZIO ADAM , three wide the first turn, steadily retreated.
