FIELD ARTILLERY sprinted clear early, set the pace in the two path, widened the advantage in mid stretch while under strong pressure then held sway the final sixteenth. TRIPLE VISION settled off the rail, advanced between rivals into the stretch, continued between foes past the three sixteenths pole, altered out some in mid stretch and finished with good energy through not able to seriously threaten the winner. EXPECTANCY bobbled then was bumped leaving the gate, rated back along the inside, moved in tandem inside TRIPLE VISION nearing the quarter pole then could only muster a mild late response. CAFE KOMODO rated just off the early pace, angled out leaving the three eighths pole, made a mild four to five wide under urging leaving the three sixteenths pole then flattened out late. HARK THE HERALD chased the winner three wide and weakened. LIFASI , sluggish early, was outrun while three wide into the stretch, angled in near mid stretch but failed to generate the needed run. J B'S TOP HOOK broke inward and bumped EXPECTANCY, raced removed from the rail and was outrun.
