Footnotes

GROOVY SOUL saved ground to the stretch, eased outside near the quarter pole, bid for the lead in midstretch, dueled and narrowly prevailed. SILBER STERN came in on EXCHANGINGMEMORIES leaving the starting gate, sped to the front, set the pace well off the rail, dueled the final furlong and missed in a sharp effort. EXCHANGINGMEMORIES , bumped and forced in leaving the starting gate, circled the turn, chased the pace to upper stretch then gave way. ARETALLEY drifted out leaving the starting gate and was no menace. CRUISE MORE , bumped and pinched back leaving the starting gate, raced well off the rail and gave way in upper stretch. PRIZED PUPIL bore out sharply leaving the starting gate, making a major contribution to the jam up at the start, was outrun and raced very wide entering the stretch. SLEW CAT FEVER dropped back. WHISKEY KEG dropped back. Following a stewards' inquiry, SILVER STERN was disqualified and placed fifth. An objection by the rider of CRUISE MORE against EXCHANGINGMEMORIES for alleged interference leaving the starting gate was not allowed.
