IDLE HOUR saved ground stalking the pace, eased out to the two path leaving the turn, aggressively split horses near the quarter pole, angled outside near the eighth pole, closed determinedly and was up in time under vigorous rousing. QUEENAMEINA stalked the pace, raced four wide on the turn, bid for the lead near the quarter pole, dueled through the lane and just missed in a game effort. MAY ONE bobbed at the break, had speed in the two path, dueled much of the race and weakened late. ANGEL I B disputed the pace three wide, was done in upper stretch and gave way. MISS MEADOW was outrun. BROAD CONTOUR , wide, chased the pace to the stretch then faltered. ROBYNS ANTHEM saved ground, dueled to the stretch then faltered.
