### Footnotes

RONDAS BACK set the pace along the rail, was set down in upper stretch and pulled away under brisk urging. BALTIMORE BIANCA saved ground stalking the pace, eased out to the three path leaving the far turn and gained the place. PRINTASTICAT prompted the pace outside the winner and faltered. PEPPER JOANN, outrun, raced in the two path on the far turn and passed tired rivals. NORTHERN DELIGHT, three wide both turns, chased the pace, drifted to the six path in upper stretch and faltered. ALASKAN DAWN, four wide the first turn, raced in the three path on the far turn and dropped back. SMOOTH ASTER, steadied on the heels of a rival entering the first turn, stopped.
