**Footnotes**

LATINO DANCER set the pace slightly off the rail, drifted out near the quarter pole and dug in late to prevail. DREWMANCHU rushed up six wide near the five eighths pole, remained wide around the turn, brushed HAM AND ERNIE when drifting in near the eighth pole, continued to drift in during the drive and steadily closed the gap. HAM AND ERNIE circled the turn, was brushed near the eighth pole and weakened late. KITTY PLEASER , two wide on the turn, chased the winner and weakened. WANTED FUGITIVE , three wide between horses on the turn, eased out for the drive and gave way late. BLAZEN , two wide on the turn, gave way. ROADMARK raced along the rail and dropped back.
