GREAT HARBOUR cleared early, set a rated pace towards the rail, opened up in upper stretch then held firm under a mild drive. ALL FOR PEACE stalked the pace, edged closer leaving the far turn, chased under a ride into the lane and finished gamely to cut the gap. SAFETY VALVE saved ground under rating, made steady progress into the lane, eased out and lacked a bit of room late while closing the margin. NIGHTSCAPE, unhurried early off the rail, swung wide nearing the lane and had some late interest. WOTAN lagged back off the rail, came five wide for the drive and had a mild rally. SEATTLE PROSPECT stalked the pace three wide and faded. INTO THE WIND broke a step slow, was rank under restraint down the backstretch, raced four wide into the far turn and came up empty. ARTIC CRY was steadied lightly nearing the first turn, stalked between rivals near the half mile marker, remained in range to the head of the lane then tired. HE DEVIL hustled up to contention, chased two wide to the far turn then stopped.
