ENCAUSTIC lacked speed, raced near the rail on the turn, eased out four wide in upper stretch, switched to his right lead near the sixteenth pole and was along in time. MR. MADISON, rated down the backstretch, eased out three wide entering the stretch, gained the lead nearing the sixteenth pole and gave way grudgingly. SKELETON CREW set the pace near the rail and gave way late. HANDSOME BRUNO prompted the pace two wide and gave way. ROCKY BLUE, outrun, raced wide entering the stretch. SLIP JIG stopped.
