Footnotes

CHO TIME broke a step slow, settled early, commenced a run off the rail three furlongs out, angled further out and circled four wide making headway into the lane, rallied under left handed pressure to take command a sixteenth out and held firm under a drive. STAR MANEUVER sprinted clear, set the pace in the two path, was confronted by the winner inside the eighth pole, dueled and stayed on gamely. COBBLER'S MARK broke sharply then was rated back off the lead, was under snug rating between rivals stalking the pace, had to tap on the breaks when eager three eighths out, shifted in towards the rail for the drive and continued on willingly to close the gap. PROUD TRICK , between horses early, chased around the turn, angled out leaving the three sixteenths marker but lacked the needed bid. PETIE'S BOY was steadied awaiting room behind rivals near the three eighths pole, shifted off the rail, came three wide for the drive, steadied off the heels of PROUD TRICK when that one angled out in upper stretch, altered wide and finished willingly. TOOTH N CLAW stalked the pace three wide, was under pressure chasing between rivals in upper stretch, failed to kick on and weakened. PHOTOGENIC rated four wide early while not far back, edged closer three wide mid turn, chased into the stretch and faded. THE FRENCH BEAR lacked speed, raced six wide into the lane and was outrun. THAT'S EXTRA forced the early pace inside, tired after a half and drifted out. Following an objection by the rider of PETIE'S BOY, PROUD TRICK was disqualified from fourth and placed fifth for causing interference in the stretch
