ENJOYABLE moved up three wide into the far turn, angled in when advancing into the stretch, waited patiently near the furlong marker, got through along the rail a sixteenth out, responded to right handed pressure and edged clear. HIGH HILL lacked speed, angled out five wide for the drive and closed willingly. SUZZONA cleared early, set the pace inside, drifted out late and gave way grudgingly. BATTINGSTAR , within range early while saving ground, angled out for the drive and had a mild late response. LINSALATA (IRE) stalked the pace under rating, had dead aim in mid stretch and weakened. PROFIT , four wide into the lane, lacked a rally. ANGEL I B saved ground and had no response. UPTOWN BOOTS chased the pace and weakened. JAKE'S GOLD was outrun.
