Footnotes

GIGI'S MANDATE rated forwardly in the five path off of a contested early pace, inched closer three wide under rating to join the leaders mid turn, took over approaching the stretch, responded to pressure and drew away through the final three sixteenths of a mile while being kept alert. PRINCESS SUCREE rushed up along the inside to join the early pace battle, disputed the issue to upper stretch, chased the winner in a willing fashion past the furlong marker then had enough left late to save the place. QUITE AN ECLIPSE saved ground in range early, angled out mid turn, worked her way between rivals leaving the three sixteenths marker and continued on with interest. ROYALTY FOR ONE broke outward, was taken back soon after and guided to the inside, rushed up past the three quarter pole, angled out around the turn, circled five wide into the stretch, made a slight advance then flattened out. ETOILE NOIRE vied between rivals early, was steadied when in close nearing the turn, dropped to the inside, chased the dueling leaders then faded in the drive. AUTUMN'S DISPUTE , four wide between rivals stalking the early pace, remained in a striking position to the quarter pole then gave way. SMOOTH JAZIRA , taken to rate early, made a decent four wide run mid turn, chased the leaders into the stretch and gave way. GALLANT KITTYKAT , wide, was outrun. PIPER'S PUNCH set a pressured early pace in the three path, dueled between rivals from the three eighths pole to upper stretch then weakened. OH PLEASE was outrun. PRIESTLY GOLD stopped after a half and was eased through the drive. ASHLEY'S INDIAN was badly outrun.
