Footnotes

EIGHTTOFASTTOCATCH eased back off of REGAL WARRIOR under the wire the first time, rated comfortably three wide, gathered momentum leaving the half mile marker, moved to collar the leader approaching the stretch, kicked clear in upper stretch, responded to solid right handed pressure leaving the eighth pole, drifted out slightly near the sixteenth pole then held sway. CACTUS CHARLIE, taken to rate removed from the inside, edged closer past the three eighths pole while still under some restraint, angled out four wide nearing the quarter pole, made a menacing run into the stretch, shifted in past the sixteenth pole and finished gamely. NOT ABROAD saved ground while well back early, gained ground under a ride mid way on the final turn, angled out entering the stretch, shifted back to the inside in the drive but came up empty in the final furlong. FRED HIGH, unhurried early, angled out four wide into the stretch and had some belated action. REGAL WARRIOR was sent up from the outside to go clear, dropped in entering the first turn, set a moderate pace under rating, was tackled by the winner leaving the five sixteenths pole, gave little resistance and tired through the drive. IN THE JUICE settled back off the pace, came well wide for the drive and gave way. SUMACHA'HOT was outrun.
