MISTY'S HOPE sprinted up inside to take command leaving the chute, set a quick but rated pace along the inside, took pressure from DISTORTEDAMUSEMENT mid way on the turn, responded to rousing in upper stretch and steadily widened through the final furlong. DISTORTEDAMUSEMENT, away alertly, prompted the pace two wide, was put to urging leaving the far turn, moved to challenge mid turn, pressed the winner into the lane then gave way grudgingly in the final eighth of a mile. GORDON'S LAST saved ground while well back early, eased out mid turn, swung five wide entering the stretch, made a run nearing mid stretch then flattened out late. SOUND THE CHARGE, two to three wide chasing the pace, came up empty. MY PROBLEM TOO chased the pace while saving ground and faded. TOKORIKI lost ground four wide and failed to respond. DON CE SAR bore out at the break and gave way. QUARTERS, in tight at the break, dropped back.
