Footnotes

POCKET PATCH chased the pace outside EIGHTTOFASTTOCATCH, overtook that one in upper stretch then drew out under brisk urging. HAM AND ERNIE, patiently handled, advanced two wide between horses on the far turn, angled outside in midstretch and rallied. EIGHTTOFASTTOCATCH sped to the front, set the pace near the rail, remained prominent to the sixteenth pole then faltered. DAY FLIGHT chased the pace, was well off the rail in the stretch and faltered in upper stretch. RAVEN'S CHOICE, three wide the first turn, was outrun and passed tired horses late. MONEY FOR LOVE, three wide the far turn, faltered approaching the stretch. GIN'S SOUR GIN was badly outrun. INTO THE WIND was outrun. LOVEBEGON, wide the first turn, chased the pace to the far turn then faltered.
