## **Footnotes**

BALTIMORE BELLE rated kindly behind a three way scramble on the front end, worked her way between rivals in upper stretch, dueled, edged clear under strong right handed pressure near the furlong marker then steadily edged away while kept to her business. LIL KIARA dueled between rivals, held a short advantage into the stretch while three wide, battled outside the winner past the furlong marker and gave way grudgingly. KINCORALYN was hung out three to four wide while disputing the pace, continued a solid forward presence past the three sixteenths marker then faded in the final sixteenth. MISS SPEAK lost ground four to five wide and continued on willingly. BEN'S BOOTS, taken to rate early, made a solid run along the inside leaving the three eighths pole, angled out three wide to loom in upper stretch then flattened out. TOUGH TALKIN LADY, jostled and pinched back at the break, lagged well back for a half mile, raced extremely wide in the drive and had some belated action. STOWE WHITE stumbled at the break, recovered to quickly reach a stalking position four wide, raced forwardly while continuing four wide around the turn then gave way in upper stretch. WEEPER, forced in and bumped leaving the gate, was straightened away and rushed up inside rivals to contest the pace, held a short lead into the turn, was headed early turn, remained a factor along the inside to the head of the lane then tired. SQUABBLE broke outward and was roughed up soon after, was steadied nearing the three quarter pole, raced three wide between rivals nearing the turn, faltered after five and a half furlongs and was being eased late. FLOMAR was jostled at the break, rushed up along the rail soon after, chased the early pace and faltered. There was a stewards' inquiry into the start of the race but no action was taken
