Footnotes

FLEETWOOD STEVIE broke sharply then was content to stalk a contested pace, was put to a strong ride mid turn, angled four wide gaining momentum into the lane, rallied under left handed encouragement to collar CANIGETAWITNESS in mid stretch, briefly edged clear, was joined from the inside past the sixteenth marker and dug in under strong handling to prevail. IGNITE , taken to rate early, angled in around the turn, slipped through inside in upper stretch, sustained her rail run to challenge the winner inside the sixteenth pole, battled gamely and just missed in a sharp debut. CANIGETAWITNESS took over early, secured the inside after three sixteenths, briefly lost command near the half mile marker, regained command early turn, took outside pressure while remaining under rating, shook clear nearing the lane, drifted out in upper stretch, maintained a slim advantage to mid stretch then weakened late. SEVENTH RULER lacked speed while off the rail, angled five wide for the drive and had some belated action. SANDY THE BEAR flashed speed inside, dropped back near the three eighths pole, shifted out four wide in upper stretch, made a mild run between runners near the sixteenth marker then flattened out. EASILY DONE bobbed inward at the break, recovered and moved up outside to poke a head in front after a quarter pole, was headed soon after, dueled past the five sixteenths marker, could not keep up into the lane and tired. FEMME DE JOIE was pushed inward at the break, raced four wide past the three eighths pole and failed to menace.
