Footnotes

BROADWAY PRODUCER, forwardly placed, raced between rivals leaving the far turn, waited patiently mid way on the final turn, angled out and circled six wide into the stretch, moved to even terms in mid stretch, dueled and narrowly prevailed in a solid drive. **DR RICO**, taken to rate, moved closer along the inside into the far turn, waited briefly past the three eighths pole, shot through a rail opening into the lane, gained a slim lead past the three sixteenths pole, dueled with the winner from the furlong marker and just missed in a sharp effort. **KNIGHT IN ARMOUR** tracked the leaders three wide, lodged a bid leaving the three eighths pole, gained a short lead into the stretch, held well to mid stretch, faded and drifted out late. **GAMMY'S A WINNER** dueled along the rail through slow early fractions, steadied when in tight leaving the far turn, angled out near the three eighths pole, came back some between rivals near mid stretch and finished willingly. **D. J.'S HERO**, between rivals early, eased out three wide down the backstretch, moved four wide to challenge nearing the quarter pole then weakened leaving the eighth pole. **INTO THE WIND** steadied when rank nearing the wire the first time, angled out and raced wide around the final turn then lacked a response. **HOUND** disputed the pace two wide, moved clear leaving the far turn, battled to the head of the lane then tired.
