Footnotes

SPOTTED SILVER rated five wide early while forwardly placed, advanced three to four wide to take command into the stretch, kicked well clear in mid stretch then held sway under a drive. SHE'S OUR HERO , between rivals early, dropped back a bit around the turn, came four wide for the drive and closed willingly to just get the place. AMBUSCADE , four to five wide early under a rating hold, lodged a bid into the turn, vied around the turn and into the lane and stayed on well while just losing the place. CLAY'S A HERO , taken to rate early, moved to a striking position early turn, eased out for the drive and came up empty. GLYNDON PARK vied briefly inside, was shuffled back some nearing the turn then failed to recover. MISS MATTY C cleared early, set the pace along the rail, took pressure around the turn, was headed entering the lane then tired leaving the three sixteenths marker. ALLEN FLIER , between rivals early while stalking the pace, dropped back around the turn.
