BALTIMORE BOB moved up between rivals under a rating hold mid way down the backstretch, steadied briefly around the far turn, advanced inside mid way on the final turn, angled out approaching the lane, closed determinedly under pressure and got up at the wire. GENERALISSIMO saved ground early while stalking the pace, eased out near the far turn, lodged a bid between rivals nearing the quarter pole, dueled through the lane, took a slim lead late, battled gamely and was nipped at the wire. RUN JICKSTER RUN cleared early, set the pace inside, was collared after six furlongs, dueled on a short lead past the eighth pole then gave way grudgingly in the final yards. FREE DUBAI settled early, saved ground into the lane, swung out late and closed willingly. BOB'S DREWMAN stalked the pace off the rail, lodged a three wide bid nearing the quarter pole, pressed briefly and weakened. SUNFEST dropped back. NO TIME TO FLIRT stalked the pace four wide and tired.
