**Footnotes**

MAGICAL MERRY stalked the pace slightly off the rail, eased out near the quarter pole, closed, bid for the lead near the sixteenth pole and narrowly prevailed. NEO'S GRAND FINALE , along the rail leaving the backstretch, eased out on the turn, swung to the five path entering the stretch and closed late. SINCEREST saved ground, dueled through the stretch and faded in the drive. SWEET ENERGY , wide the far turn, bid for lead approaching the stretch, drifted in in upper stretch, dueled and weakened late. MITIGATE saved ground on the far turn, eased out in upper stretch and failed to rally. EMMA HAMILTON lacked speed, was never a factor and passed tired horses. MON CHOU , in the six path turning for home, was outrun. PEBBLE TO A PEARL , along the rail through the stretch, gave way. EMERALD SONG , wide the far turn, gave way in upper stretch. WILD AWAKE prompted the pace well out from the rail and faltered leaving the far turn.
