QUICKSTEP MELODY advanced along the rail on the far turn, swung outside in upper stretch, took command approaching the eighth pole and held sway under energetic urging. KEVIN'S STEEL stalked the pace while well off the rail, swung wide in midstretch and rallied late. WORK IT OUT , swung wide in upper stretch, rallied late. ENGLISH SARAH worked between horses in the stretch and rallied. YEOHO disputed the pace outside EL REY'S REINA and

tired the final furlong. SUMMER COURT , very wide turning for home, passed tired foes. BERNING LASS , swung to the six path entering the stretch, passed tired horses. EL REY'S REINA hugged the rail, disputed the pace to midstretch then tired. PIETRA DURA , reluctant to load into the starting gate, failed to rally. BUFFY was steadied and bore out entering the first turn, failed to be a factor and entered the stretch very wide. SCIPION'S GIRL chased the pace, raced in the three path on the far turn and faltered. MAYPOLE DANCER , four wide the first turn, was outrun and entered the stretch in the eight path. NASHLY LOVE , wide the first turn, stopped. JUST PLAIN FANNY bore out and was very wide entering the first turn.
