JAZZY IDEA chased the pace outside SPRING DANCE, overtook that one inside the quarter pole, was put to energetic urging and pulled away. SPRING DANCE sprinted clear leaving the backstretch, saved ground on the turn, was no match for the winner but was well clear of the rest. OK LISTEN UP lacked speed, raced in the two path between horses on the turn and passed tired foes. LADY CIRCLE stumbled leaving the starting gate, saved ground around the turn and faltered in upper stretch. SWEET DISTRACTION, outrun, swung to the six path in upper stretch. TWO HEARTS IN ONE, outrun, saved ground on the turn. COCO PUNCH, no factor, steadily retreated. BLUEGRASS ATATUDE showed speed in the three path, faltered on the turn and was eased in the stretch.
