KATES BU MOON cleared early, set the pace off the rail, opened up in mid stretch and held sway under a drive. WHATA RUBY GIRL , a bit fractious pre race, saved ground near the half mile marker, swung out four wide entering the lane, drifted in briefly leaving the three sixteenths marker, switched to her correct lead late and steadily gained. PRINCESS CIARA lacked speed, came five wide for the drive and closed willingly. AVIE'S ROBERTA , a bit rank at the break, lacked speed while saving ground, angled out in the lane, split rivals late and finished willingly. SASSY HEARTED stalked the pace three wide and weakened. FORMAL GRACE , two wide past the three furlong marker, chased the pace around the turn and gave way. RAFFLING KISSES was outrun. USAGE DU MONDE (FR) was done after a half mile.
