Footnotes

RAM lacked speed, moved up outside horses, gained the lead in midstretch and lasted. SAHARA KING lacked speed, worked between horses, angled outside in upper stretch and rallied gamely. KING TING (IRE) set the pace along the rail and gave way late. DARK INVADER raced between horses and passed tired ones. MOVING WEST , very wide on the far turn, passed tired horses. TROPIC SEA lacked speed and passed tired foes. NEW REVOLUTION , three wide the first turn, raced four wide the far turn and gave way. CALL TO ORDER gave way. POWERFUL KOREA (KOR) prompted the pace two wide and faltered. UNBRIDLED TUNE , wide the first turn, faltered. JOLLY JOE , wide both turns, gave way.
