TAHOE KID bobbled at the break then was in a bit tight soon after, hustled up and lodged a four wide between rivals nearing the turn, dueled two wide around the turn, raced between rivals past the eighth pole, took command under strong handling past the sixteenth marker and held sway. LITE UP THE NITE set the early pace three wide, dropped to the rail early turn, dueled from mid turn to late and battled gamely to the end. QUESHUA , five wide rating close nearing the turn, stalked three wide around the turn, moved to a short lead in upper stretch, dueled nearing the sixteenth marker and was outfinished. D' LIGHTFUL APPEAL , within range while off the rail, came five wide for the drive but could not muster the needed rally. NO CROSSING LANE vied early between foes, was bumped and shuffled back entering the, regrouped to make a mild four wide run into the stretch then flattened out late. CRYPTOLEEN'SCHARM stumbled at the break, saved ground into the lane and failed to respond. INDRAN lost ground four to five wide and was under a mild hand ride in the drive. INSIDE THE PARKER vied early inside, bumped with NO CROSSING LANE entering the turn then faltered.
