HORST raced along the rail, dropped back on the turn, swung outside near the quarter pole and rallied mildly. I CAN DO IT prompted the pace outside the winner and weakened in the drive. WILLEM saved ground around the turn, angled out in midstretch and failed to rally. BIG BOPER stalked the pace off the rail and gave way. GAEL LEA raced in the two path on the turn and was outrun. LION ON THE FLOOR circled the turn and was outrun.
