ACTIN LUCKY sped to the front, set the pace near the rail, opened up near the eighth pole and prevailed under brisk urging. SALSA BULLET lacked speed, saved ground around the turn and closed strongly along the rail. VALIANT STAR , a forward factor along the rail early, angled out near the four and a half furlongs pole, remained in the two path, chased the pace and came up empty in the drive. MISS HARD TEN , wide around the turn, weakened in the drive. SWEET SUSAN chased the pace, raced in the three path between horses entering the stretch and gave way in upper stretch. ANGELS CONCERTO raced in the two path on the turn and was outrun. BRANDY'S CHAMP circled the turn and dropped back.
