Footnotes

GO THE DISTANCE prompted the pace three deep under rating, took over in upper stretch, shook clear in mid stretch, drifted out a bit then dug in under strong handling to prevail. FRIDAYS GIFT moved up along the rail nearing the five eighths pole and gained a stalking position behind a three pronged pace exchange, eased out around the turn, awaited room nearing the lane, bumped with ALARMING AFFAIR when working between rivals in mid stretch, was straightened away and finished gamely outside the winner. ALARMING AFFAIR was bumped at the break to be away last, angled wide in the opening furlong, moved up four wide to reach contention into the far turn, came under a ride leaving the three eighths pole, circled five wide continuing a progression into the lane, bumped with FRIDAYS GIFT in mid stretch then kept on willingly. TAP ALL NIGHT stumbled at the break but quickly regrouped, dueled between rivals from the five eighths pole to upper stretch, kept on willingly past the furlong marker, faded late and had her rider drop his whip. LOVE THE BREEDING , away alertly, was caught in a pace battle along the rail soon after, came under pressure into lane, stayed willingly to mid stretch then faded. EMY ELLA came out at the break bumping ALARMING AFFAIR, stalked between rivals early, swung wide on the turn but failed to respond. OFF CHANCE came in at the break and was bumped, chased three wide and gave way.
