A LADY'S CARESS stalked the pace, raced three wide around the turn, bid for the lead in midstretch and edged clear under urging. HALO'S GEM disputed the pace two wide and faded. REGAL MIRACLE lacked speed, raced very wide and rallied. SILVER SNOW chased the pace and needed more. PRINCESS DREAM , no factor, raced wide. LOVELY FORTUNE , rushed to contention early, saved ground, dueled and tired. CLASSY HEROINE was outrun. SHAKESPEARE CRITIC , checked in tight quarters near the six furlongs pole, weakened along the rail.
