WILLA ON THE MOVE bumped at the start, raced well back in the early stages, rapidly closed the gap on the turn, circled five wide into the stretch, charged to the front a furlong out then edged clear under good handling. FINALLY HERE raced just off the early pace, rallied along the rail to challenge on the turn, battled into midstretch but was no match or the winner. BRONZE ABE broke inward at the start, sprinted clear in the early stages, set the pace under pressure on the turn then weakened in the final eighth. CARNIE'S DANCER was reserved for a half, rallied four wide on the turn then improved her position in the stretch. FOR RUBIES stalked four wide for a half and tired. DECK GAME failed to threaten after bumping with the winner at the start. VALLEY PARKING never reached contention. GLORY OF LOVE bobbled at the break, pressed the early pace between horses and faltered on the turn.
