Footnotes

CHARMED BY CHARLIE prompted the pace four wide, lodged a bid in hand mid turn, took command nearing the stretch, repelled a challenge from SUAVE LINE in mid stretch then kicked clear under a drive. SUAVE LINE settled off the rail, rallied five wide in upper stretch, drew to near even terms in mid stretch then flattened out. HANAIE BAY rated close up, advanced four wide into the lane, angled in leaving the three sixteenths marker, lodged a bid in mid stretch then was outfinished. RINKA BELL prompted the pace along the rail to the head of the lane, drifted out a bit then came up empty. RIPE , allowed to settle, saved ground when advancing into the lane then flattened out. MOMMYUMS lacked speed, raced five wide in the drive and lacked a solid late kick. IN THE MOOD set the early pace three wide, dueled nearing the lane then gave way. ROSES FOR MARIA stalked the early pace between rivals and dropped back.
