THIRD OFFENSE , well placed under a light hold and off of a contested pace, cruised up four wide nearing the quarter pole, took command in upper stretch, kicked clear when roused left handed then widened under solid hand pressure in the final sixteenth. ANTHONY J. , outrun early while off the rail, was urged along near the three eighths pole, angled out three to four wide for the drive and finished up willingly to earn the place. HANDSOME BRUNO prompted the pace four wide into the turn, vied three wide around the turn then was outfinished for the place. LEAGLENOTE saved ground early, angled out for the drive, steadied when in a bit tight leaving the three sixteenths marker then lacked a solid finish. SUCCESFUL RETURN vied along the rail through the opening quarter, dropped back a bit mid turn, angled out and came up empty. LOWES ISLAND , three wide early, dueled between rivals on a short lead mid turn, continued a presence to mid stretch then faded. SIX STRING set a pressured early pace two wide, dueled along the rail mid turn, steadied briefly entering the lane then tired.
