MY PROSPECT CITY , three wide the first turn, secured command outside CHARLIE THE HUNTER mid way on the far turn, sprinted clear in upper stretch and was kept to his business in the drive. ROEDDON , between horses the far turn, angled outside in midstretch and closed nicely. THUNDER LORD advanced four wide entering the far turn, chased the winner to upper stretch then gave way. STRAIGHT TO IT , four wide both turns, finished willingly. SHARP NUMBERS , steadied in traffic entering the backstretch, mid way down the backstretch and entering the far turn, swung very wide approaching the stretch and was not a factor. SOUP D'COUPE , wide the far turn, failed to rally. BUNDESTAG (GB) raced along the rail and gave way. CHARLIE THE HUNTER showed speed, saved ground on the far turn and faltered entering the stretch. CORVINO had brief speed along the rail then stopped mid way down the backstretch.
