FOLLOW THE LEADER came away in good order, rated kindly while stalking the pace four wide, had the leaders in his sights entering the lane, responded when set down inside the quarter pole, closed relentlessly under strong handling and forged clear in the final yards. MORE THAN CANDY set the pace off the rail, met the challenge of DANDY WALTZ approaching the stretch, shook well clear of that rival departing the three sixteenths pole, continued gamely while drifting out but could not withstand the winner's onslaught. SMILING JORDAN settled well off the pace, came seven wide for the drive and rallied mildly. ALBRECHT, taken to rate, raced two to three wide into the stretch, made a slight move between rivals then lacked the needed finish. OCONEE GOLD stumbled at the break, raced wide mid turn, made some progress in mid stretch then flattened out. DRAYTON HALL lagged far back, swung very wide and passed tired rivals. DANDY WALTZ prompted the pace three wide, moved to threaten leaving the three eighths pole, pressed to the quarter pole then tired. LIVE THE DASH saved ground and weakened. PONI COLADA, ridden along the rail mid turn, angled out but failed to threaten. GRANDE GAYEGO stalked the early pace three wide and faltered.
