TIGER RAG set a pressured pace racing near the rail and drew out under urging. JANE'S KID , unhurried early, raced wide in the stretch and rallied. COME CLOSE prompted the pace outside the winner and weakened. MACH THREE raced between horses and failed to rally. ROI DE VIOLETTE saved ground and weakened. BACK TO EVEN raced between horses and weakened. CROW'S NEST was outrun. DOMENICK'S DUNE , outrun, swung to the six path in upper stretch. MABOU was outrun. MATT BLANC (IRE) raced between rivals and gave way. AMERICA'S DARLIN unseated his rider when hitting the outside of his starting gate stall.
