SUPERDUPER MISS was sent to contention between rivals, stalked the pace off the rail, surged to command leaving the furlong marker, raced on her left lead late and was fully extended to prevail. GODMOTHER, bumped leaving the gate, angled three wide mid way on the turn, advanced between rivals approaching the eighth pole and finished gamely inside the winner. LAGAYLIA, two wide on the turn, moved closer in mid stretch then flattened out. KNOT SO CLEVER, bumped leaving the gate, rushed to the front along the inside, set a brisk pace, raced off the rail into the stretch and weakened near the sixteenth pole. PAPARIKA, off the rail, angled wider in the lane and lacked the needed response. MAXNIECE stalked the early issue between rivals and dropped back nearing the lane. BETTY'S STAR, four to five wide, chased the pace and weakened. LADY CRUELLA saved ground and weakened.
