WHITE GOLD raced wide and passed tired ones. SINGING LAUR raced off the rail and was no factor. SMART COLONY was outrun. LADY CASSANDRA circled the turn and fell back. DOOTS raced near the rail and was outrun. TRUE FASHION had speed along the rail and faltered.
