AKRONISM cleared soon after the break, set pace three wide into the turn, took pressure around the turn while under a bit of urging, dropped down towards the rail approaching the quarter pole, shook back clear in upper stretch then held sway under a steady drive. SILMARIL bobbled a bit at the break and bumped with LINDA'S LION, settled down the backstretch while saving ground, advanced along the rail nearing the quarter pole, eased out nearing the sixteenth marker, closed gamely and steadily gained. FOR KISSES broke a step slow, raced four to five wide early, angled in nearing the three eighths pole while under a ride, gained some ground leaving the five sixteenths marker, angled out three to four wide in upper stretch and gained the show between rivals. LA CHICA RICA bobbled inward at the break, stalked the pace under a rating hold, made a mild three wide run in upper stretch, remained a presence to the sixteenth marker then faded. I KNOW ANGEL'S OK lost ground three to four wide, made a mild run entering the lane then came up empty in the drive. WAHOO MOON , four wide early, lodged a bid into the turn, pressed the pace outside of the winner into the lane, steadied when in tight between rivals in upper stretch and faded. BLIND CANYON , in a bit tight after the break, failed to menace. LINDA'S LION , bumped at the break, raced between rivals early, angled five to six wide in upper stretch and faded.
