Footnotes

OFF THE GLASS chased the pace outside JOEL'S TOUCH and wore down that rival in an extended drive. JOEL'S TOUCH set the pace along the rail and gave way grudgingly. FIRE HERO lacked speed, raced four wide entering the stretch and passed tired rivals. IRISH COLONY saved ground, swung out in upper stretch and gave way. ROOTEEN HERO lacked speed, raced along the rail and passed tired ones. SUE'S DIAMOND , three wide the far turn, gave way. BOOGYMAN raced in the two path between horses in the stretch and was outrun. MOON BEAN gave way. BADA BAM BADA BOOM raced along the rail, swung wide at the head of the stretch and gave way. WATER CANNON , four wide the first turn, chased the pace and weakened. FLYING PEACE , four wide the first turn, stopped and was eased.
