MOLLY MOLLY MOLLY dueled outside QUARRY TREMOR, gained a clear lead entering the stretch, opened up in midstretch and was kept to her business in the drive. LADY IN THE PARK, angled to the inside entering the stretch, rallied. PEDROIA, wide around the turn, failed to sustain her bid. ANN MILLER stalked the pace three wide on the turn and weakened between horses. MILFORD BAY lacked speed, swung to the five pat near the quarter pole and gave way late. WALK SOFTLY saved ground on the turn, eased out in upper stretch and faltered. QUARRY TREMOR dueled along the rail and stopped.
