Footnotes

PLEASANT BEAU stalked the pace two wide, moved to challenge in upper stretch when roused left handed, gained a slim advantage a furlong out, dueled and proved best in an extended drive. SONOFAWITCH cleared early, set a slow pace inside, was collared in upper stretch, dueled inside the winner and just missed in a sharp effort. THUNDER CHARM, between rivals near the five eighths pole, came three wide for the drive, finished with good energy and steadily gained. BELLE'S BROKER bobbled slightly at the break, settled back early, moved up behind rivals leaving the far turn, was urged three wide nearing the lane but could only gain mildly. CINDER CONE saved ground in a forward position then weakened in the drive. GOLD CASING broke a step slow, had a wide trip and tired.
