Footnotes

AGAVE RIDGE , three wide to clear around the first turn, angled in some and set solid early fractions while nudged along, drifted out entering the stretch, ducked out when well clear near the furlong marker, was straightened away under right handed pressure and held sway. THE SPANISH LIFE saved ground while unhurried early, was put to a ride around the final turn, angled out leaving the eighth pole and closed willingly. HOUND was rated back off the winner around the first turn, angled off the rail entering the backstretch, stalked the pace into the far turn, moved a bit closer under a solid ride after six furlongs, moved back inside in the drive and went evenly in the final furlong. BAGOGA broke a step slow, settled well back off the pace, saved ground into the lane, had some belated interest but never factored. AMERICAN STEEL , well placed early, chased three wide into the lane but had no response. TIMELY WONDER , sluggish from the gate, was outrun.
